Pacific Region – Hawaii Vegetable and Melon Crops Report

HAWAII 2024 VEGETABLE CROP VALUE AT \$97.1 MILLION

The farm gate value for Hawaii's vegetable and melon crops is estimated at \$97.1 million in 2024, up 33 percent from 2022 and up 50 percent from 2021. Cumulative production for vegetables and melons was 51.9 million pounds, up 16 percent from 2022 production of 44.9 million pounds and up 15 percent from 2021. Area harvested at 5,850 acres in 2024 was up 12 percent from 2022 and 15 percent from 2021.

The top volume-producing published vegetable crop during 2024 was sweet potatoes, whose estimated production was 4.15 million pounds. The leading farm gate published value was leaf lettuce, estimated at \$6.30 million. The second largest published value was sweet potatoes, at \$4.25 million.
