### Statistics on Egg Prices Honolulu, Quarter 1, 2026

The average retail price for a dozen large, locally produced conventional eggs increased by 16% from \$8.38 in the last quarter of 2025 to \$9.71 in March 2026. The average retail price of conventional mainland eggs also increased by 8% from \$6.97 to \$7.55 per dozen over the same period. As a result, the average price differential between local and mainland conventional eggs widened from \$1.41 to \$2.16 per dozen. For larger cartons (18-count), the average retail price rose by 12% for local eggs (from \$11.68 to \$13.12) and 23% for U.S mainland eggs (from \$9.25 to \$11.42).

The average retail price for a dozen large, locally produced organic eggs increased by 5% from \$10.26 in the last quarter of 2025 to \$10.81 in March 2026. Average retail prices for organic eggs imported from the mainland increased 13% to \$9.62 per dozen, narrowing the price gap between local and imported organic eggs from \$1.71 to \$1.19 per dozen. Overall, price ranges for local and mainland eggs, across all carton sizes and for both conventional and organic varieties, were wider than the price ranges in the last quarter of 2025. Additionally, national data indicate that, since March 2025, U.S. average egg prices per dozen at retail have fallen as production has increased.

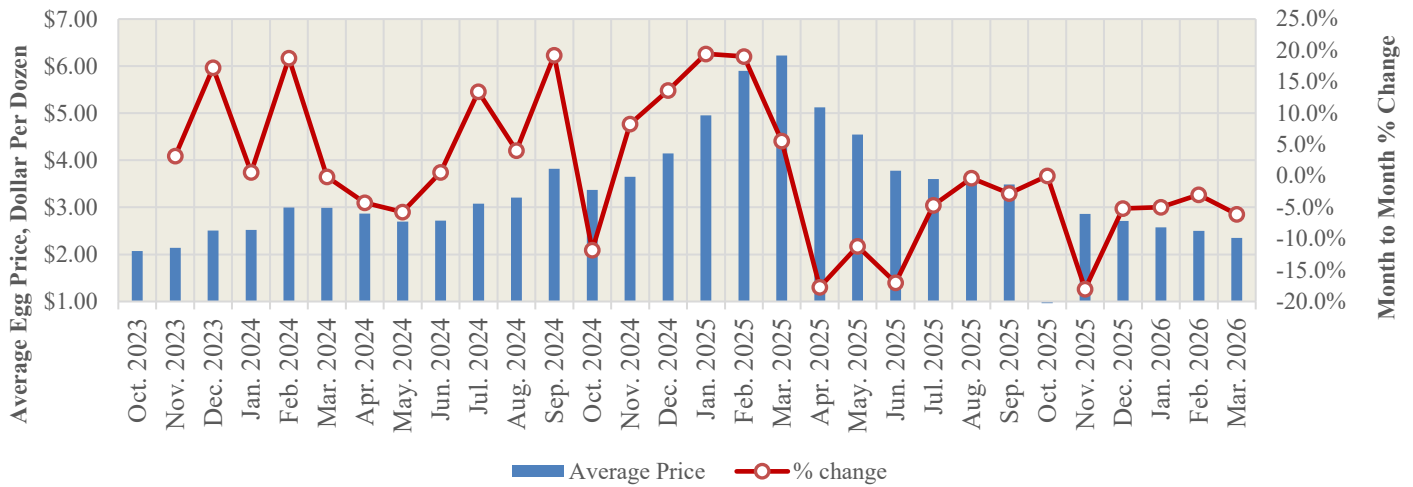

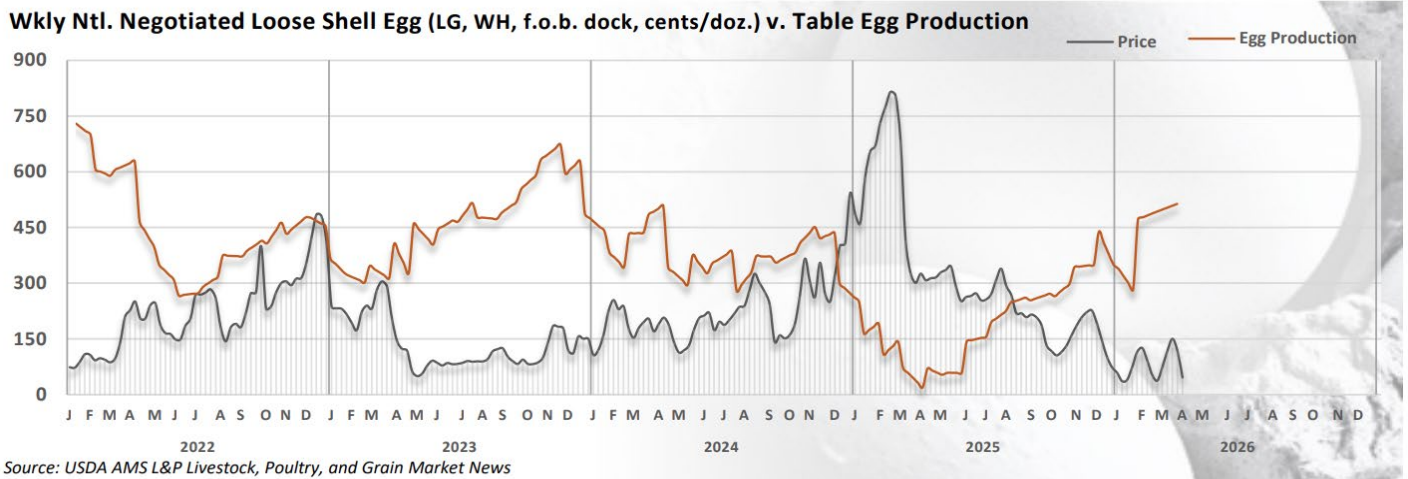
