#### Attachment to Board of Agriculture 9/26/17 Meeting Agenda

Summary of Proposed Amendments to Chapter 4-71, Hawaii Administrative Rules, Entitled, "Non-Domestic Animal Import Rules," Relating to Import Requirements For Non-Domestic Animals.

In addition to general housekeeping changes, the proposed amendments to chapter 4-71, HAR, will, among other things, do the following:

# 1. Section 4-71-1, Objectives

Adds "associated risks to animal and public health and safety" as an additional basis for restricting or prohibiting import of specific non-domestic animals.

## 2. Section 4-71-2, Definitions

Establishes a definition for "dangerous wild animals" and identifies specific species as "dangerous wild animals."

# 3. <u>Section 4-71-3, Permits</u>

- a. Deletes "dangerous wild animals" from the animals allowed for import under short-term permit for performance or exhibition in circuses and carnivals, but provides that dangerous wild animals may be imported for commercial filming for television or movies, subject to permit conditions adequate to address any associated risks.
- b. Clarifies that violation of permit conditions may result in citation or in cancellation of a permit, or both.

## 4. Section 4-71-4.1, Maximum time period for permit approvals

Clarifies that short-term special permits, as well as short-term permits for certain animals, not just for performing animals, must be processed within 120 days.

# 5. Section 4-71-5, Notice of quarantine

Adds "risk to animal or public health and safety" as another consequence of uncontrolled introduction of non-domestic animals, in addition to danger to agricultural and related industries.

# 6. Section 4-71-6.5 Permitted introductions

- a. Restates, in the lists of restricted animals that contain the individual "dangerous wild animals" species, that these species are prohibited for short-term performance or exhibition in circuses, carnivals, or state fairs, but are allowed for short-term performance for commercial filming, for exhibition in government zoos, or for other purposes permitted in the rule section.
- b. Allows government agencies to import animals on the List of Conditionally Approved Animals, which includes animals allowed for import for individual possession, businesses, and institutions.
- c. Expands the purposes for which animals on the List of Restricted Animals (Part B) may be imported, from currently allowed purposes (i.e., private and commercial use, including zoological parks, or aquaculture production) to include government use.
- d. Replaces the term "municipal" zoos with the broader term "government" zoos;

- e. Clarifies that, in addition to universities and government agencies, other institutions may import restricted list animals for research, and that universities and government agencies may import restricted list animals for medical and scientific purposes as well as for research, as determined by the Board of Agriculture.
- f. Clarifies that permits may be approved by the chairperson, as well as by the branch chief or Board of Agriculture, as specified by rules.
- g. Clarifies that site approval is required prior to the issuance of any permit issued for import of animals on the restricted lists and unlisted animals.
- h. Clarifies that the transfer or sale of unlisted animals under permit is allowed, provided the proposed transferee can satisfy conditions for transfer and obtain a permit for possession.
- Deletes Nile tilapia, Oreochromis niloticus, from the List of Restricted Animals (Part A) and adds this fish to the List of Restricted Animals (Part B) to allow its import for aquaculture production.
- j. Deletes house crickets, Acheta domesticus, from the List of Restricted Animals (Part A) and adds this insect to the List of Restricted Animals (Part B) to allow its import as feed for certain zoo animals.

## 7. Section 4-71-7, Bond for certain animals

Deletes the word, "performing," to expand the bond requirement to any animal used in a circus, carnival, or commercial filming, as appropriate.
