# REPORT TO THE TWENTY-FIRST LEGISLATURE, 2002 REGULAR SESSION

#### IN COMPLIANCE WITH

### SECTIONS 155-14 AND 219-4, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES

Sections 155-14 and 219-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, allow the Department of Agriculture to transfer funds between the Agriculture Loan Revolving Fund and the Aquaculture Loan Revolving Fund. Sections 155-14 and 219-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, also set a ceiling of \$1 million for each revolving fund that can be transferred during a calendar year; and requires the department to report to the Legislature, twenty days prior to the convening of each session, all transfers made between the two funds during the preceding calendar year and the balance of each loan fund as of December 31<sup>st</sup>.

The Department of Agriculture reports that no transfers were made during 2001.
