button found on your Zoom screen. Committee staff will individually enable each testifier to unmute their microphone. When recognized by the Committee Chairperson, please unmute your microphone before speaking and mute your microphone after you finish speaking in order to prevent audio feedback. Entomology

Request to: (1) Allow the Importation and Possession of Lab-Reared Strains of the Parasitoid Wasp, *Phymastichus coffea* (Hymenoptera: Eulophidae), an Insect on the List

of Restricted Animals (Part A), by Permit, for Field Release to Control the Coffee Berry Borer, *Hypothenemus hampei*, by the USDA ARS and UHM;

- (2) Establish Permit Conditions for the Importation and Field Release of Lab-Reared Strains of the Parasitoid Wasp, *Phymastichus coffea* (Hymenoptera: Eulophidae), an Insect on the List of Restricted Animals (Part A), to Control the Coffee Berry Borer, *Hypothenemus hampei*, by the USDA ARS and UHM; and
- (3) Determine the Probable Impact to the Environment if Lab-Reared Strains of the Parasitoid Wasp, *Phymastichus coffea* (Hymenoptera: Eulophidae), an Insect on the List of Restricted Animals (Part A) Are Accidentally Released.
