Statistics on Bananas State of Hawaii, 2021

The farm gate value for Hawaii's 2021 fresh banana production is estimated at \$5.6 million, a 22 percent increase from 2020. Utilized banana production increased 33 percent to 5.4 million pounds. Statewide banana acreage increased slightly from 263 acres in 2020 to 318 acres in 2021, excluding the Kunia region in Honolulu County.

The average yield of bananas harvested per acre increased ten percent over the previous year to 16.9 thousand pounds. Banana producers received an average price of \$1.06 per pound for fresh bananas, seven cents more than in the previous year.

About 41 percent (2.2 million pounds) of the state's utilized banana production is grown and harvested for off-island sales. Additionally, bananas grown in 2021 for sales on-island increased to 3.2 million pounds, 71 percent higher when compared to the preceding year.

Hawaii Apple bananas continue to be the main variety grown by producers. Cavendish and other varieties grown and sold include Ice Cream, Williams, and Namwa. Chart 1 on page 3 ranks other commercially marketed varieties.
