The Task Force staff will individually enable each testifier to unmute their microphone before speaking and mute your microphone after you finish speaking in order to prevent audio feedback. When testifying, you will be asked to identify yourself and the organization, if any, that you represent. We request that each testifier limit their testimony to two (2) minutes per agenda item.
